



**Transfer Admission to B.Tech. (CSE), Dual Degree B.Tech.-M.Tech. CSE and B.Tech. Mathematics & Computing – Third Semester**

Applications are invited from eligible candidates for transfer admission to the Third Semester (Second Year) of the B.Tech. (CSE), Dual Degree B.Tech.-M.Tech. (CSE), and B.Tech. Mathematics & Computing programmes against vacant seats. Admissions shall be made on the basis of merit and fulfilment of the eligibility criteria prescribed by the University.

**Eligibility**

Applicants must satisfy the following conditions:

1. Must have passed Class XII/Higher Secondary or an equivalent qualifying examination in the Science stream, with Mathematics and Physics as mandatory subjects, securing a minimum of 65% marks in aggregate.
2. Must have successfully completed the first year (two semesters) of a B.Tech./B.E. programme from a recognized institution/university, or have appeared in the second-semester examination at the time of application.
3. Must have secured a minimum of 70% marks or equivalent CGPA/SGPA in the first year. Candidates awaiting final first-year results may apply provisionally, subject to submission of final results within the prescribed timeline and clearance of all first-year courses without backlogs.
4. The branch/programme studied in the previous institution must be the same as, or closely related to, the B.Tech. programme for which transfer is sought.
5. The applicant must satisfy any one of the following conditions:
  - SAU Entrance Test 2025: Must have been included in the merit list for admission to the respective B.Tech. programme; or
  - JEE Main 2025 (Indian candidates): Must have a JEE Main 2025 score.
  - Other SAARC nation candidates (without SAU Entrance Test): Must have secured 65% marks in class XII<sup>th</sup> examination, with Mathematics and Physics as mandatory subjects.
6. Must possess a satisfactory academic and disciplinary record and submit the following documents:
  - No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the present institution;
  - Migration Certificate;
  - Academic Transcripts;
  - Syllabus and course details of the programme studied.

**Selection Procedure**

- Admissions shall be made strictly on the basis of merit, availability of vacant seats, and academic equivalence of the courses studied.
- The University may prescribe bridge courses, wherever necessary, to address curricular gaps in the curriculum.
- Mere fulfilment of the eligibility criteria does not guarantee admission.

## Application Process

Applicants are required to complete the following steps:

3. **Upload/attach the following documents** in the Google Form:
  - Academic Transcripts/Mark Sheets
  - No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the present institution (if available; however, it must be submitted at the time of acceptance of the admission offer)
  - Migration Certificate (if available, however, it must be submitted at the time of acceptance of the admission offer)
  - Syllabus and course details of the programme studied
  - JEE Main Scorecard 2025 (as applicable)
  - SAU Offer Letter 2025 (as applicable)
  - Proof of Registration Fee payment
  - Any other supporting documents, as applicable
4. Applications submitted without the Registration Fee payment proof or required documents shall not be considered.

## Fee Details

- Selected candidates shall be required to pay the fee with the details as follows:
  - a) Admission Fee (One Time): USD 200
  - b) Semester Fee: USD 1250
  - c) Student Aid Fund: USD 10
  - d) Security Deposit (One Time): USD 200
  - e) Transfer Fee (One Time): USD 100

**Note:** Dollar exchange rate is USD 1 = INR 91

- Offer Letters shall be released by 15<sup>th</sup> July 2026.
