Notice: Spot Round for Admission to Certain Postgraduate Programmes – Academic Year 2026–27

South Asian University (SAU) will be conducting a **Spot Round of Admissions** for **certain Postgraduate programmes**, for the Academic Session 2026-27 from **31st July - 2nd August 2026** (10:00 am to 4:00 pm) on SAU Campus.

This round is **open to all eligible candidates**, including those who may not have applied earlier. Admissions will be offered **strictly on the basis of merit**.

The merit will be based on

- relevant **National-level Eligibility Test** scores (CUET-PG, GATE, CAT, MAT etc., as applicable)
- Or
- Qualifying Bachelor's degree (as per the programme-specific eligibility criteria on the SAU Admissions Website) with a minimum of **60% marks** or an equivalent grade.

Important Information:

- Candidates will be issued **tokens at the time of reporting**, and the admission process will be carried out accordingly.
- Candidates must **report in person from 9:30 am to 12:30 pm**. **Late reporting shall not be considered.**
- Candidates provisionally offered admission **must pay the requisite fee - including the registration fee, Admission Fee, Security Deposit, Programme Fee & Student Aid Fund, immediately at the venue**. **Failure to pay the fee at the time of admission through Spot Round will lead to cancellation of the offer.**
- Hostel accommodation is available to a limited number of students and shall be allotted strictly in order of merit, subject to availability.

Candidates must carry the following documents at the time of reporting:

- Original and photocopies of academic certificates and mark sheets
- Valid proof of eligibility test scores (JEE/CUET/GATE/CAT etc.) - Original and photocopies
- Government-issued photo ID (Passport, Aadhaar, etc.)
